Local Scout Leaders Aid With Training

Little Falls scouters are playing an important part in the scoutmasters' basic course currently being conducted by the leadership training committee of the General Herkimer Boy Scout Council.

Participating on a faculty that includes ten experienced scouters, are Paul Agrelius, council leadership, training committee chairman; Francis Ashe, scoutmaster of Troop 51; Robert Beaslee, assistant scoutmaster of Troop 51, and John Finnegan, scoutmaster of Troop 24.
