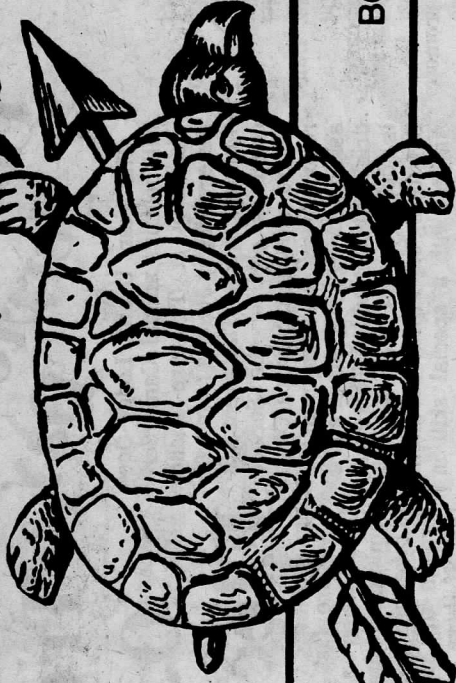

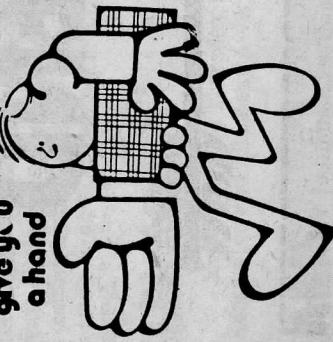

# Meet our new Director of Camping - Steve Gerber

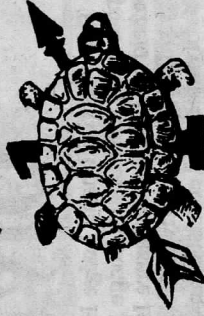
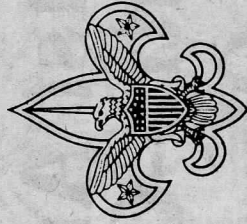
Mr. Gerber comes to us from Bergen County Council located in Northeastern New Jersey. While at Bergen Council he was Program Director for 4 1/2 years.
