Swimming in Darby Creek, about 1 mile away.	Scout tests must be passed. Signaling prize is offered to the troop making the best record at this camp.	A beautiful camp site on Trout Run, 3 miles from trolley. Excellent place to pass every scout requirement. No better camp site in the country.
