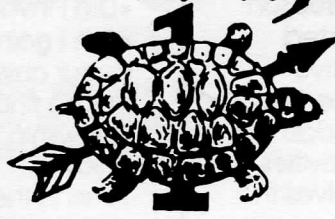

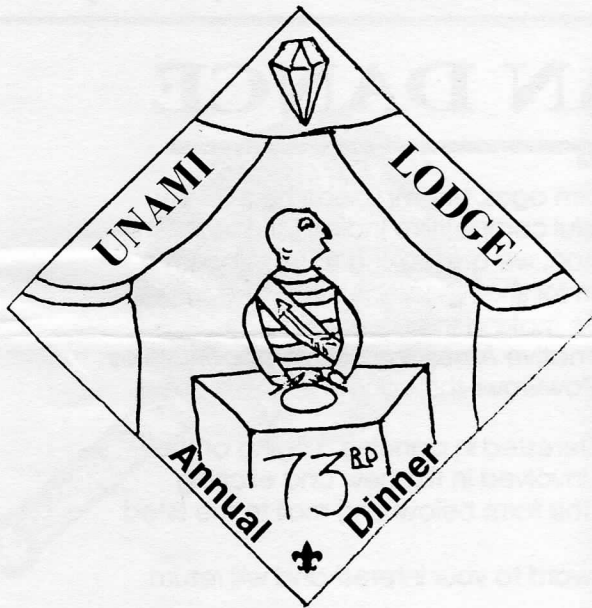

LETTER FROM THE CHIEF


Dear Brothers,

- If your answer to any of these questions was "no" please find a way to get involved and join the fellowship of Unami Lodge. Involve yourself and enjoy!

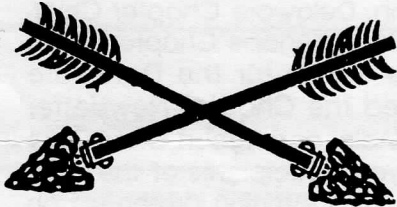


INDIAN DANCE

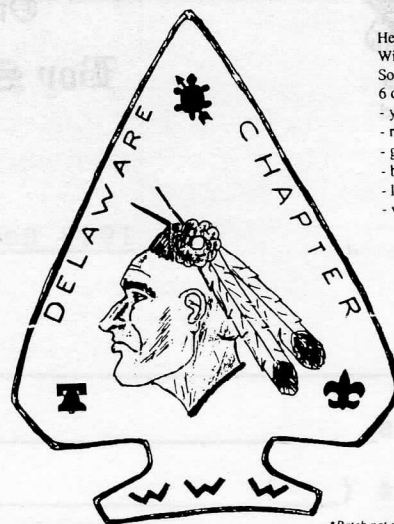

The Delaware Chapter Patch is now open to all members of Unami Lodge. This fully embroidered patch contains six colors: yellow, red, green, black, light brown, and white.

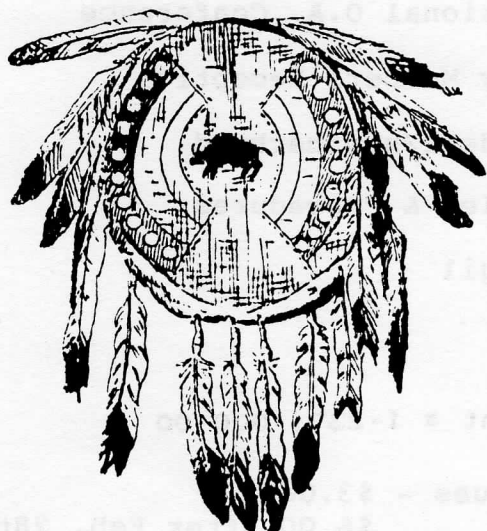
