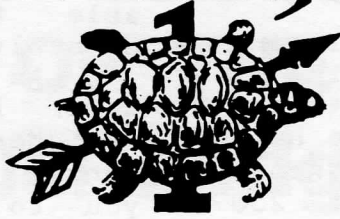

## LETTER FROM THE CHIEF


Dear Brothers,
