HIS GRADE-SCHOOL teachers took a rather dim view of the idea. Here was a healthy, husky boy wasting his time, noons and recesses, as well as good paper or chalk, just drawing pictures. Several unimpressed instructors were about to take Ralph Crosby Smith in hand and try to make something out of him. But they didn't — and the talented youngster literally drew his way through high school. Animals of all kinds and wild-life proved to be his long suit for Smith grew up on a farm, earned his first dollars with a trap-line and spent his leisure moments hunting and fishing near Fair Oaks, California.

His Art career began in earnest during Ralph Crosby Smith's first year at Sacramento Junior College. While drawing had always been lots of fun, here he began to think of Art as a means of making a living. From there, on through the University of California, Smith majored in Art with but one thought in mind — to be an illustrator, and a good one. Two years at the Wilmington Academy of Art with instruction from nationally-known illustrators, provided the post-graduate polish he needed and soon the ambitious young man was handling illustrative assignments for the National Home Monthly of Winnipeg. General magazine and book work, covering everything from romance to historical, kept him busy for long periods, but the adventure and out-of-doors paintings always found Smith at his best.

American sportsmen appreciate pictures such as "Off Limits" because the situations are the "it-happened-to-me-once" type and the scenic backgrounds look startlingly familiar. One can almost imagine himself playing the trout in this lively illustration, without the slightest idea that three bears — out looking for lunch — feel someone is poaching in their private pool. No matter who gets the fish, it's a cinch the startled fisherman will take himself away from there in a hurry. A hungry mother bear, with her cubs, is not very pleasant to meet. And besides, there are plenty of other spots nearby that are not "Off Limits."
