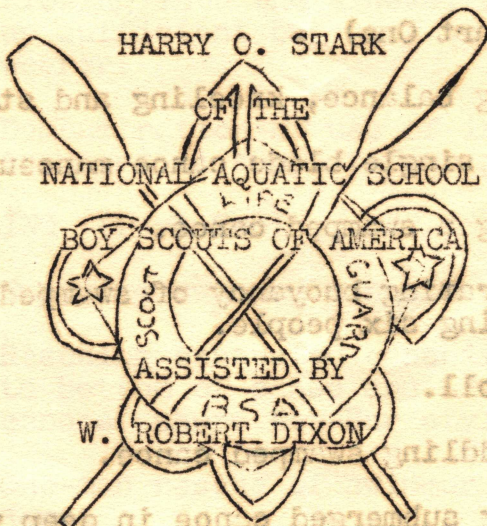

PROGRAM

SWIMMING

Brief demonstration of swimming strokes used in Merit Badge Swimming Requirements to emphasize good form which should be expected of those taking the examination, including rescue by use of shirt, stick, branch, & paddle, following disrobing of rescuer. (Jumping entry).

CANOEING (Part One)

Teaching balance, kneeling and standing.

One-man single blade canoe manoeuvres.

Boarding a swamped canoe.

Demonstrating buoyancy of swamped canoe supporting six people.

Canoe roll.

Hand-paddling swamped canoe.

Emptying submerged canoe in deep water by kicking out and shaking out.

Protecting a Troop Swimming Party.

LIFE SAVING

A demonstration of the following Life Saving methods:

Swimming rescue with rope. In this event, three Scouts on shore - one disrobes, carries rope to subject, and is hauled back to shore by his companion.

How to avoid being seized. (Defense against grasps).

Torpedo buoy rescue and resuscitation.

Demonstration of inflating shirt by blowing into the sleeve, and so building up sufficient buoyancy to support the wearer.

Demonstration of use of inflated cotton trousers to support four persons.

CANOEING (Part Two)

Emptying swamped canoe over rescue canoe.

Rescuing exhausted canoeist, hanging on to bottom of canoe and bringing both canoes ashore Ben-Hur style.

One-man rescue of swimmer about to go down.

Two canoeists rescue and resuscitation of a man who has gone down.

One canoeist rescues and resuscitates a man who has gone down.
