Dear Jubilee Jamboree Explorers:

Enclosed you will find:

1. Your Valley Forge Jamboree Registration card.
2. Three baggage tags (Mark in pencil - NOT INK) for your luggage enroute to Valley Forge. (We will be in Section 29).
3. Two Valley Forge Jamboree Emblems (Sew on shirts above right pocket).
4. Four Jubilee Jamboree emblems. One for right pocket of red jacket and 3 for the right pockets of your green shirts.
5. A sheet carrying our addresses while on the tour.

Extra emblems may be purchased at Valley Forge. Two of the above Jubilee emblems were purchased from our contingency fund so that you will have them ahead of time.

Our 2 Valley Forge and 3 Jubilee Neckerchiefs will be issued to us individually when we arrive at Valley Forge.

We do not wear Patrol medallions on our uniforms.
