Tue. July 30	PLYMOUTH	Steamer will be at port by daylight, an early disembarkation will be arranged. Transfer to Birmingham.

Mon. Aug. 12)	SUTTON COLD-FIELD	International Boy Scouts Jamboree, official dates August 1 to 12 inclusive.
^{Tues} Wed. Aug. 13	BIRMINGHAM/ LONDON	By train or motorcoach to London.
Wed. Aug. 14	LONDON	Morning free. Afternoon city sightseeing of London by motorcoach with guide. Drive via Hyde Park, Buckingham Palace, Westminster Abbey, House of Parliament, Big Ben, Piccadilly, Regent Street and Oxford Street.
Thu. Aug. 15	BRUSSELS	By day service from London.
Fri. Aug. 16	AMSTERDAM	Morning city sightseeing in Brussels by motorcoach with guide via Ste. Gudule Church (visit), Unknown Soldier Memorial, Parliament, National Shooting Gallery (rifle range visit), King's Palace, Palace of Justice, Grand Place, Stock Exchange. Afternoon train to Amsterdam.
Sat. Aug. 17	DUSSELDORF	Morning tour by motorlaunch in Amsterdam with guide through the canals, passing beneath numerous small bridges, over narrow canals like Heerengracht, where seven bridges in different directions may be seen at one time. Trip also visits Harbour of Amsterdam.
Sun. Aug. 18	WIESBADEN	By motorcoach to Coblenz. Thence Rhine Steamer.
Mon. Aug. 19	HEIDELBERG	By motorcoach from Wiesbaden via Frankfurt. Afternoon sightseeing in Heidelberg by motorcoach with guide via Town Hall, Holy Ghost Church, Molkenkur, St. Peter's Church, Old and New University, Student Prince House, View Tower (overlooking Heidelberg).

Tue. Aug. 20	LUCERNE	By motorcoach to Lucerne.
Wed. Aug. 21	MONTREUX	By motorcoach from Lucerne via the Rhone Glacier and Interlaken with guide, via Kussnacht, Axenroad, Altdorf (Tell's Country), Gorge of Schoellenen, Andermatt, Furka Pass (8000 ft.) Rhone Glacier (7000 ft.). (Stop for lunch), Meiringen, Lake of Brienz, to Interlaken. Thence continue by motorcoach to Montreux.
Thu. Aug. 22	MONTREUX	Full day tour by motorcoach to Geneva by motorcoach driving via Lausanne, Nyon and Versoix to Geneva. Sightseeing in Geneva including visit to the League of Nations, Cathedral Museum and <u>Reformation Monument</u> . Return to Montreux in the late afternoon via the French side of the lake.

Sat. Aug. 24	PARIS	Full day city sightseeing by motorcoach with guide including Opera, Place Vendome, <u>Ste. Chapelle</u> , Sorbonne, Luxembourg Gardens, Pantheon, Notre Dame, Madeleine Church, Arc-de-Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, Tomb of Unknown Soldier and many other points of interest.
Sun. Aug. 25	PARIS	Morning free. <i>American Church!</i> Afternoon sightseeing to Versailles by motorcoach with guide via Place de la Concorde, Champs Elysees, St. Cloud to Versailles. Visit Palace and grounds, Museum of Carriages and Petit Trianon.
Mon. Aug. 26	LE HAVRE	By boat train from Paris. Sail on M. V. FAIRSEA for New York.
