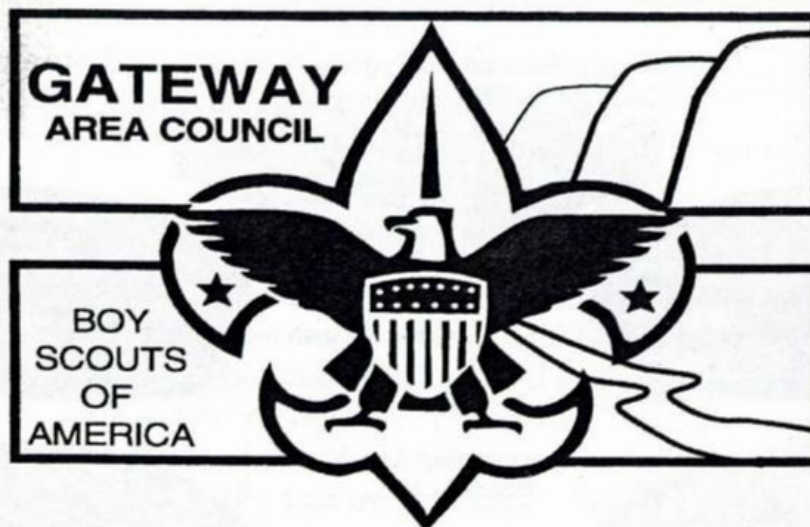

The extraordinary set of river patches. These five patches represent the 10 rivers of Western Wisconsin and the Coulee Region. The Bad Axe, Trempealeau, Root, Mississippi, Kickapoo, Buffalo, La Crosse, Chippewa, Black, and Wisconsin rivers make up the five similar patches.

They all have blue borders and a green background. To set them apart from each other each river has a symbolic image next to it's name. These patches were taken by the Gateway Area Council to the National Jamboree in 2001 to trade. There was about 400 patches made and only 50 of the Mississippi and Root rivers are left. Only 150 of the Kickapoo and Buffalo are left. We have only 126 of the Chippewa and La Crosse, and only 133 of the Bad Axe and Trempealeau. We have 156 of the Black and Wisconsin river patches left, but all of these patches are going fast so order yours today.



NATIONAL JAMBOREE 2001

Red border, red, white, and blue background. Official 2001 Jamboree patch for Gateway Area Council. We still have 603 patches and they are being sold for \$5 each. These are still great trading patches.

Black border/older design for Gateway Area Council brought back for the 2001 National Jamboree. There are 480 patches and they are \$5 each.

2001 National Jamboree patch with troop number 1422. Black border with red, white, and blue background. Writing is yellow and numbers are white. This patch sells for \$8 and we only have 18 left. HURRY!

BOWL-A-THON



The 1998 Bowlathon patch. This CSP had three borders made originally. The red border was issue was for Scouts who recruited 10 sponsors. The purple border was awarded to Unit Leaders that conducted a bowlathon. And the white border was awarded to Scouts who recruited 25 sponsors. There originally were 50 red, 25 purple, and 25 white borders made. All we have left are 3 red border patches and they sell for \$5 each. So hurry, we never know when these will be gone. (ID BOWL 98)



This is our 1999 Bowlathon patch. It is a normal size Council Shoulder Patch and only costs \$5 each. Our 1999 patch originally came in three colors; green, red, and purple. Now at the Gateway Area Council Scout Shop we only have 22 green, 13 red, and 20 purple left. (ID Green- BOWL GREEN, Red- BOWL RED, Purple- BOWL PURPLE)

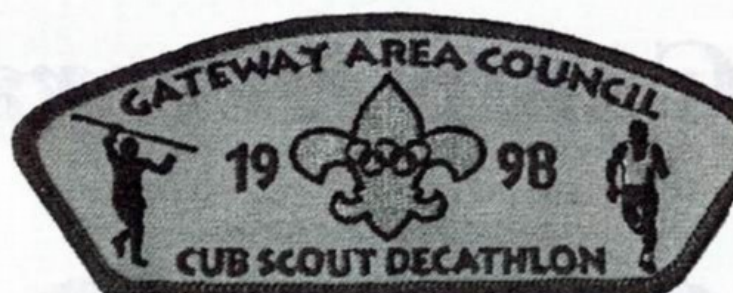
Camp Decorah



This is the 1998 C&F dedicated to our beautiful Camp Decorah. This patch is unique in the fact that it reflects our outstanding C.O.F. course. There were three different patches created. All of the patches have the same design but with different color borders. The red border is sold out and only 100 were made. There were 50 silver mylar and 50 gold mylar patches created. We only have 8 gold mylar and 8 silver mylar patches left. Order them before they're gone forever. (C&F C&F)



The Camp Decorah Campership patches are unique in the fact that money received from them goes to help a needy Scout spend a memorable week at camp. The patch itself is very attractive. The background is yellow with black characters and Camp Decorah Campership in red lettering. We have three border colors for this C&F. Right now we have 17 Black border patches, 21 red patches, and only 15 yellow patches left. These sell for \$10.00 each and not only do you receive a nifty patch but you help a Gateway Area Council Scout on his way to "Do His Best". (C&F-Campership)



This is our CSP dedicated to our 1998 Cub Scout Decathlon. This patch has a yellow background with blue lettering and the 1998 in red. To complete this unique patch it has a red border. They sell for \$5 each, and we only have 5 left.. (ID CUB)



This is Gateway Area Council's Scouting for Food Council Shoulder Patch. It has a yellow background and a green border. This patch sells for \$5 each and we only have 63 left. This is a great trading patch, order yours now. (ID Scout For Food)



1998 was the 150th birthday for the state of Wisconsin. The Gateway Area Council has issued two CSPs to celebrate the state's Sesquicentennial. The green border issue was given to everyone attending the Council Annual Dinner. 400 of the green border patches were issued and 340 were given away the night of the dinner. The remaining patches were sold in the following years. In addition to the green patches, there were 100 silver mylar CSP's produced. We only have 7 silver mylar patches left. This historical CSP is sold at \$10.00 each. (ID WI 150)

The 1995 Spring Recruiter for Gateway Area Council. This CSP has a very pretty sea green background and a silver mylar border. We have only 1 of these oversized patches left and it is \$8. (ID recruiter 95)



This is the newest Gateway Recruiter CSP. With a rust border and a beautiful illustration this is a must for a patch collector. We only have 28 of these council shoulder patches left and they are \$10 each. (ID Recruiter rust)





Gateway Area Council 5 Star University of Scouting Council Shoulder Patch. This CSP has a red border, green background, and yellow banner and stars. We also have a purple border patch available as well. They sell for \$5 each and currently we have 52 red border and 6 purple border patches left. Hurry and get yours today.
