Two hundred and seventy five Boy Scouts and twenty five leaders attended the Second Annual Southern Illinois Camp-O-Ree held at Lake Benton, four miles north of Benton.

Scouts from fourteen Southern Illinois Cities began camping activities with registration Friday morning. One hundred and fifty boys registered before 10:30 a.

The first meal was prepared by the boys Friday noon, followed by group games led by James Chandler of Carbondale. Swimming and golf were a part of the athletic program of the afternoon. Inspection of camps and food was made by the officers of the camp during the supper period.

Under the direction of Ray Ashley of Ray Ashley of Marion and James Chandler of Carbondale group singing and stunts by the patrols were enjoyed by the Scouts. Mr. Leland P. Lingle, assistant athletic director of the Southern Illinois Normal University, spoke to the young men on "Preparedness and Spirit".

Officials reported a peaceful night was had by all. Saturday morning, following an "early" rising, inspection was made of the camps. During the afternoon patrol stunts were performed.

The Court of Honor was held Saturday night. Sunday morning Chapel exercises were conducted by the Rev. Paul Smith.

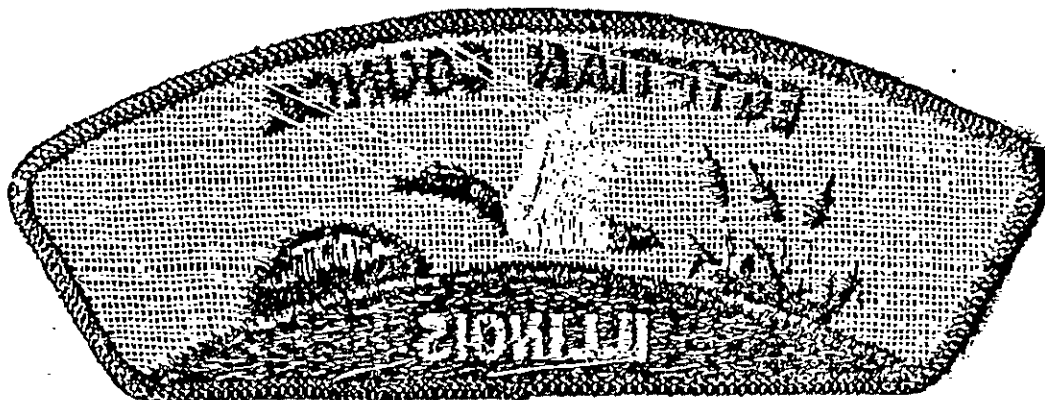
1. Twill left rough(TLR), no plastic back, fine mesh netting on back of csp thick wings, thin and thick red letter types, 1973
2. TLR, no plastic back, course mesh netting on back of csp thick letters, thick wings (two twill backs shown)
3. TLR, smooth plastic back, sun slightly separated from horizon, thin wings with blue thread, thin letters, dark blue border
4. TLR, rough plastic back, thick wings, 1978
5. Fine horizontal twill, rough plastic back
6. TLR, thick rough plastic back(i.e. stiff) 1979
7. TLR, thin plastic back rough 1979-80
8. TLR, course mesh netting on back, thick rough plastic back 1980
9. TLR, course mesh netting on back, thick rough plastic back, light blue stitching in border on back, thick dull red letters 1980
10. TLR, course mesh netting on back same as #8, but also has light blue in border on back like #9
11. Like #6 except clear nylon thread in back of border 1981



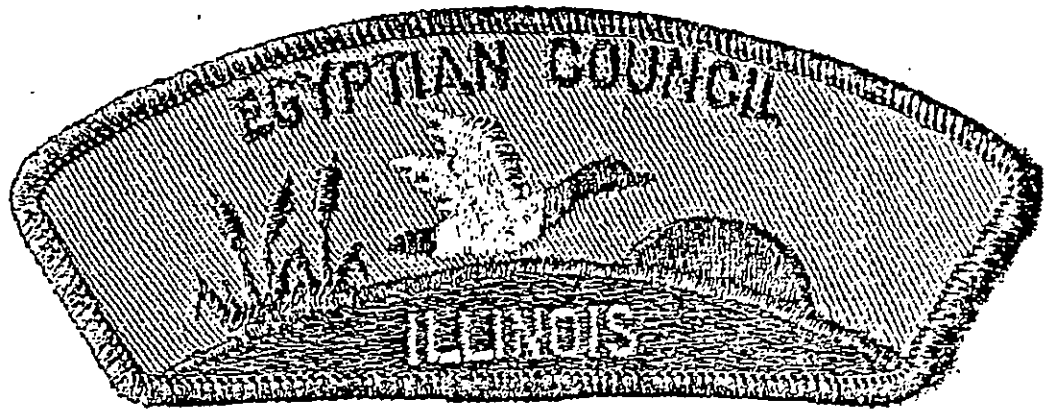
