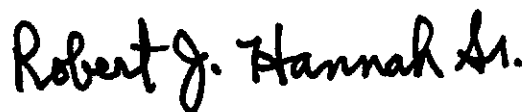
The Charles L. Sommers Base Program Director, Joe Mattson^f, has also spent many hours helping me with dates and information. His help was invaluable during this project.

Northern Tier Canoe Base Programs

The Northern Tier High Adventure Canoe Bases is owned and operated by the Boy Scouts of America. The Northern Tier Canoe Bases consist of three different canoe bases in Northern Minnesota and Canada. These bases include Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base, Donald Rogert's Atikokan Canoe Base, and Bissett – Northern Expeditions. The canoe bases are a “must experience” for any scout or scouter.



Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base

Originally named the Region Ten Canoe Base, the Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base is located near Ely, Minnesota, and is the headquarters for the Northern Tier High Adventure Bases. Open since 1942, the Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base currently serves between five and six thousand boy scouts each year. These scout and scouters explore either the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness or the Quetico Provincial Park. The Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base is also the home of the Okpik Winter Camping Program and Order of the Arrow Wilderness Voyage.

Donald Rogert's Atikokan Canoe Base

The Donald Rogert's Atikokan Canoe Base resides on Perch Lake outside of Atikokan, Ontario - “The Canoe Capitol of Canada.” Since 1972, scouts and scouters have found their way up here to enjoy canoe camping in either the northern end of the Quetico Provincial Park or the White Otter Wilderness.

Bissett – Northern Expeditions

Open since 1972, the Bissett Canoe Base is located in Bissett, Manitoba, which is 150 miles north of Winnipeg. Bissett crews charter float planes and get dropped off into the Atikaki Park, an area specializing in fresh water fishing and remote wilderness canoe trips. This is much more remote than the other two bases, offering a unique experience.

Okpik Winter Camping

Hosted at the Charles L. Sommer's Canoe Base, Okpik provides a variety of winter programs for scouts and scouters to enjoy. Started in 1972, Okpik now provides the following programs: cold weather camping, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, dog sledding, musher camp, winter shelter building, ice fishing, and tracking.

Order of the Arrow Wilderness Voyage

First operated in 1999, the Order of the Arrow Wilderness Voyage is a joint program between the Boy Scouts of America and the United States Forest Service. Each summer about 100 arrowmen from across the country spend two weeks in the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. The first week the arrowmen spend repairing canoe trails, then the second week they spend on a canoe trip they plan.

Northern Tier History

1923 - First Canoe Trip

Directed by Scout Executive, Carl Chase, Virginia, Minnesota.

1925 - Third Annual Scout Canoe Trip

Trip began at Winton, Minnesota, and was attended by Carl Chase, a scoutmaster, assistant scoutmaster, and six scouts. Each Scout paid \$5.85 for the 7-day trip and bought \$2.50 worth of food.

1926 - Region Ten Canoe Trails Began in Winton, Minnesota

H.F. Pote, Regional Scout Executive from St. Paul, Minnesota, recruited two canoe enthusiasts and volunteer scouters to make it a regional sponsored project. These two scouters were Frank A. Bean and Charles L. Sommers.

1933 - Operations moved to Moose Lake

Moose Lake was 17 miles deeper into the wilderness, allowing crews to get deeper in the wilderness. This also gave crews five different routes versus the two they had in Winton. The Canadian Border Lodge prepared the meals for crews and staff allowing the staff to focus on outfitting and planning.

1936 - Moved to Hibbard's Lodge on Moose Lake

Hibbard had a bunk house which slept 40 people. The inventory included 9 -17' and 8 - 16' canoes. Guides were paid \$15-\$25 a week.

1941 - Permanent Home Found

The canoe base finally found a permanent home when they leased 1.6 acres of land from the U.S. Forest Service further up Moose Lake Road. The lease was \$25 annually.

1942 - Charles L. Sommers Wilderness Canoe Base

The work on The Lodge was completed and the base was dedicated to a humbled Charles L. Sommers.

1943 - 40 Additional Acres Acquired for Canoe Base Area

1946 - Bay Post Constructed

A two-story service building was erected and stood until it was taken down during the winter of 1980-1981.

1972 - A National BSA High Adventure Program and the Okpik Program Began

The Charles L. Sommers Wilderness Canoe Base became one of the BSA's National High Adventure Programs and the Okpik Winter Camping Program was started.

1973 - Satellite Bases Created

The idea to create satellite bases in Canada was born, which led to the creation of the Bissett and Atikokan bases.

1983 - Birth of Northern Tier High Adventure Bases

Northern Tier High Adventure Bases was created through the merger of the Charles L. Sommers Wilderness Canoe Base and the Northern Wisconsin Canoe Base.

1986 - Northern Wisconsin Canoe Base Closed

1987 - Land Swap to Gain Ownership of Base Property

Land swap with the U.S. Government to get ownership of land where the canoe base resides. Over the years, several new, permanent buildings were erected.

1993 - Sommers Alumni Association Began

Pledged \$110,000 for renovation and restoration of The Lodge building.

1998 - 75th Anniversary Celebrated

2003 - 80th Anniversary Celebrated

2004 - New Bay Post and Tent Drying Buildings Completed

The old Bay Post is torn down and a new one is constructed, along with a tent drying facility.
